GOVERNMENT AERODROMES (LANDING AND PARKING FEES)

1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this AIC is to notify all persons that the Government of the Turks and Caicos Islands has revoked the Government Aerodromes) landing and Parking Fees) Regulations and introduced revised landing and parking fees.

The regulation also seek to introduce three new fees, namely

- (1) The air navigation facilities fee; and
- (2) The apron user fee.

2. SUMMARY

The Government Aerodromes (landing and Parking Fees) regulations fee changes shall come into operation on the 1st July 2008. It makes provision for owners/Operators of airlines and private aircraft to pay Turks and Caicos airports authority in respect of each landing at an airport under the control of the Airports Authority for air navigation facilities fee. It also makes provision for users' fees to be paid by airside ground handling operators in respect of each vehicle used by them at an airport.

- I. Owners/Operators of airlines and private aircraft will pay Airports Authority a fee as stipulated in the schedule for each landing and parking at an airport under the control of the Airports Authority
- II. Owners/Operators of Vehicles airside will pay Airports Authority a Vehicle Permit Fee in respect of each vehicle operated airside at all airports under the control of Airports Authority, at a rate as set out in the schedule
- III. Drivers/Operators of a vehicle airside will pay Airports Authority a fee in respect of each driver driving airside at all airports under the control of Airports Authority, at a rate as set out in the schedule
- IV. Owners/Operators of airlines and private aircraft to pay Airports Authority a navigational facility Charge in respect of landings as set out in the schedule

The Airports Authority request your cooperation in the application of these fees details of which are listed below:-

- a) The Airports Authority shall invoice all holders of an air operator's certificate monthly for landing fees, Parking fees, and air navigational facility charges. All such fees are to be paid within thirty days of the invoice date or as formally agreed by Airports Authority in writing.
- b) Apron user fees are to be paid at the time of application.
