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SALT CAY AIRPORT AIRSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Turks and Caicos Islands Airports Authority (TCIAA) is proceeding with an Airside Improvements Project at the Salt Cay Airport to enhance the operational safety/security at the facility.

Construction is to commence in August 2019 and last until November 2019.

The project consists of the following major components:

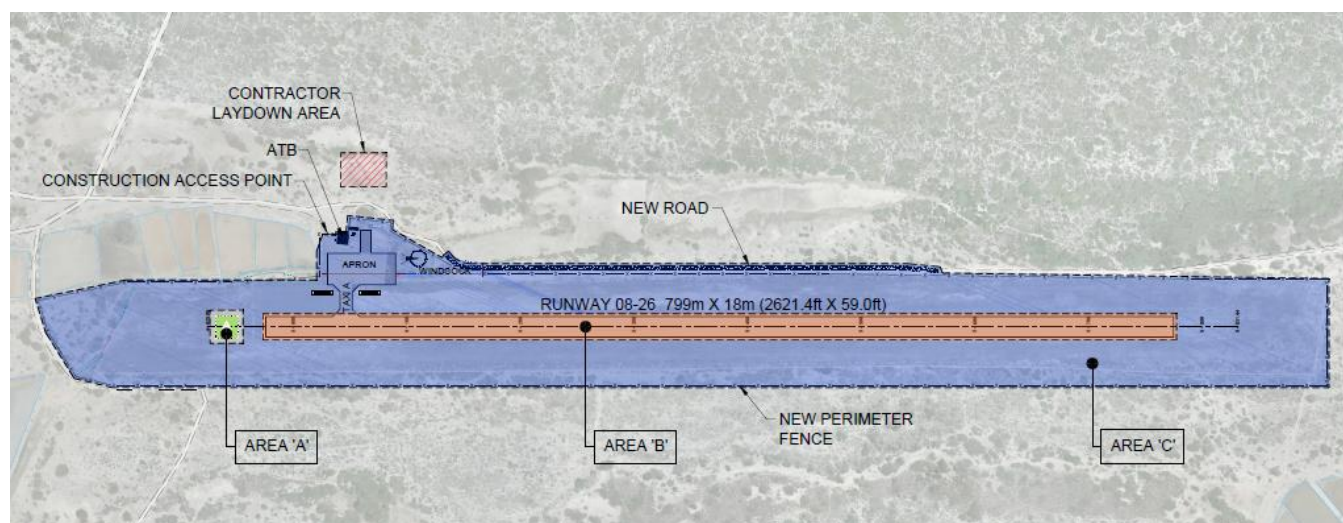
- Runway 08-26 Rehabilitation
- Taxiway A Rehabilitation
- Apron Rehabilitation and Expansion
- Storm Drainage Improvements
- Various Airfield Electrical Works
- Installation of Airport Perimeter Security Fence

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Salt Cay Airport will be CLOSED throughout construction.

Work will be separated into 3 areas to ensure helipad availability for Medevac flights.

- AREA A includes work for construction of the Temporary Helipad for Emergency Medivac flights.
- AREA B work includes work for Runway 08-26 Rehabilitation.
- AREA C includes work for Taxiway A and Apron Rehabilitation and Apron Expansion.



SCHEDULED FLIGHTS

There will be no scheduled or unscheduled flights at the Airport for the duration of the project. Airport will be NOTAMed CLOSED.

Unscheduled charter and general aviation services will not be permitted. Airport will be CLOSED for the duration of the project.

EMERGENCY FLIGHTS

The Airport will remain CLOSED while work is being completed for the project. Runway is not available for any emergency or Medevac flights during entire duration of the project.

A temporary helipad will be made available for emergency Medevac flights only, with 30 minutes prior permission required. Both arrival and departing emergency flights shall be accommodated. The temporary helipad will be lighted and painted.
