A. **PURPOSE**

The Turks and Caicos Islands Airports Authority (TCIAA) is seeking qualified

contractors to perform comprehensive land surveys, completed with levels, contours

and marking out of specificied proposed infrastructure at Clifford Gardiner

International Airport, North Caicos. These surveys will serve as vital reference points

for the North Caicos Redevelopment initiative.

B. COMPANY BACKGROUND

The TCIAA is a statutory body established in 2006 following the split of the Civil

Aviation Department into the Civil Aviation Authority and Airports Authority. TCIAA

is mandated for the constructing, controlling, and managing of airports; providing and

maintaining runways, taxiways, and terminals for the efficient operation of airports;

providing facilities for Customs and Immigration Services, and Health and Security

checks; and for incidental and associated purposes.

C. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The contractor will be responsible for performing detailed surveys across multiple areas

of the Clifford Gardiner International Airport in North Caicos. The surveys will provide

needed information that will guide the planning, design, and implementation phases of

the project.

Intended Areas of Survey

The surveys are to be conducted at the following locations:

i. Survey and Marking of the Proposed Road to the New Terminal Site:

Perform a detailed topographical survey of the proposed road alignment from

the main road to the new terminal site location.

Mark out the roads boundaries, elevations

Establish reference points for future construction.

ii. Survey of Existing Runway:

Conduct a comprehensive survey of the exisiting runway and surrounding

areas to establish accurate elevations

- Provide markings and reference points for ongoing and future runway related

maintenance work.

- Ensure compliance with aviation standard and safety regulations

- runway strip.

iii. Survey of New Proposed Fenceline:

- Perform a detailed survey and marking out of the designated fence line around

the airport perimeter.

- Ensure that the survey includes precise measurements and alignments that

comply with secuirty and regulatory standards.

- Provide clearly visible markings to delineate the fenceline for future

construction.

- Provide layout site plan of the fenceline

iv. Survey for Underground Utilities/Infrastructure:

- Survey and mark out the proposed utility route including location of

underground services such as water, electrical and communication lines.

- Mark key points such as trenching locations, manholes and junction boxes for

future excavation and installation activities.

Deliverables:

Contractors are to submit comprehensive survey reports with detailed measurements,

levels, and markings. Clearly indicating the boundaries, contours, and elevation data

for each surveyed area.

Contractors must mark/peg all key points for future reference during construction,

ensuring that all markings are clearly visible for the duration of the construction phase.

The contractor MUST coordinate with TCIAA to ensure that survey results are aligned

with the overall development plan.

AutoCAD files for integration with existing airport design documents.

Digital and hard copies of the final survey data and as-built documentation.

D. PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

The Proposer shall include in its proposal, at a minimum, the information outlined

below in a manner that demonstrates the Proposer's competence and qualifications for

the satisfactory performance of the services identified in this RFP.

Your proposal should be supported by:

1. Completed and signed Certificate of Non-Collusion.

2. A TCIAA Corporate Profile Sheet / TCIAA Client Profile Sheet to be filled

out as appropriate and accompanied by relevant supporting information.

3. Detailed approach to how the survey work will be performed, including

equipment to be used, and quality control.

4. Proposed timeline for completing the work outlined in the Scope of Work.

The information outlined below may be used as a guide to demonstrate your and you

company's competence and qualifications for the satisfactory performance of the scope

of services identified above.

1. Statement of Qualifications:

a. The Proposer shall provide a cover letter expressing interest in the project and

providing a brief overview of their experience in developing projects of a

similar size, scope, and complexity as required by this RFP.

b. The Proposer shall provide a statement of qualifications including a valid

business license and any other qualifying documents, demonstating your ability

and resources to perform the required services.

c. A statement as to whether the Proposer is presently or in the past involved in

any litigation and or if the Proposer has ever been disqualified, removed, or

otherwise prevented from proposing or continuing service.

2. Methodology

The proposer is required to present a detailed approach and methodology of the

scope of services required, demonstrating a clear understanding and their ability to

comeplete within agreed cost and duration.

3. Work Plan

The proposer must submit a detailed timeline or work plan outlining project

schedule. This schedule should demonstrate the proposed duration for the

completion of the specified works as outlined in the Scope of Services above.

4. Complete Project Pricing

Provide detailed breakdown of costs including labor, equipment and any other

anticipated expenses.

E. SELECTION PROCESS

All proposals will be reviewed and assessed based on, but not limited to service quality,

experience, and pricing.

The TCIAA reserves the right to reject a non-responsive proposal that does not include

the documents required to be submitted by this RFP.

The TCIAA reserves the right to request clarifications or additional information from

any or all Proposers regarding their proposals.

The TCIAA also reserves the right to negotiate the agreement with the highest-ranked

years.
